HARLEY EARL HAS CONCLUDED TESTS

Manager Harley Earl of the Don Lee Coach and Body Works has just concluded a series of very interesting tests, which have extended over a year. The purpose of the experiment has been to determine the grades of paints and varnishes best adapted to the California climate.

All recognized quality brands and all grades have been used on company cars, which have been subjected to all weather conditions of all seasons.

Earl has reached the conclusion that the light, quick-drying paints and varnishes do not stand up as well as the heavier grades. The quality which shows to best advantage on the Southern California cars has been adopted as standard.

Earl has also arranged to have a number of special shades prepared for the exclusive use of the Don Lee Coach and Body Works.
